

Cascade Attachments

Established in Portland, Oregon in 1943, the Cascade Manufacturing Company started as a small machine store employing just 4 people. Total sales for that year totaled 60 thousand dollars. The very first recorded sales revenues involved the machining and assembly of stainless-steel pipe fittings, valves and other parts. Throughout 5 years of operation, the business had stretched to forty staff and their yearly sales volume had risen to three hundred thirty thousand dollars. At present, Cascade is amongst the top worldwide manufacturers in the material handling trade.

Manufacture and design of the company's original hydraulic cylinder paved the way in Cascade's aggressive pursuit of better business opportunities. Over the past sixty years, the material handling industry has grown into a highly advanced area and Cascade has proudly performed a part in this growth. Cascade at the moment continues to grow as the premier provider of lift truck attachments and different related products. The business feels confident in their capability to continue to lead the way in the business by understanding client's requirements in the future and remaining aggressive within the global market.

All through the 1950's, Cascade started to fabricate, design, and advertise its hydraulic attachments. A new facility was constructed in 1956, to accommodate all plant operations and offices in Portland, Oregon, which remains to be the company's current headquarters. Following 15 years of business, total employees reached one hundred eighty workers and sales had reached almost 2.3 million dollars.

1959 in Springfield, Ohio the next manufacturing plant was built. nineteen sixty marked Cascade's initial transfer into the international world of the material handling industry while the business recognized interest in Australia, the Netherlands and England.

In the year 1964, the company changed its name to the Cascade Corporation. Afterward in 1965, the company went public with an initial offering of 200,000 shares of common stock. Ever since then the company has expanded its manufacturing facilities within the continental USA to the locations Warner Robins Georgia to go along with its already current plants in Springfield, Ohio and Portland, Oregon. Cascade products are fabricated worldwide due to a lot of subsidiary operations. In the year 1944, a new facility was accomplished in Almere, the Netherlands which is Cascade's European command center. This plant is built to be the ultimate customer service centre.

Continuing to develop, Cascade expanded their product offering further in the year 1996 and 1997 with the remarkable acquisition of 5 corporations, along with the global best in blades, the Kenhar Corporation.
